Registration

Registration begins on January 19, 2010 for Leesburg Community Church families, PLC families, and Dominion families.

Registration opens to the public on Feb 2, 2010.

Annual Fees: Registration \$200

(After 1st child, each additional child in family is \$175.)

Monthly Tuition

2 1/2 Year Olds

2 day: Mon/Wed or Tues/Thurs \$190

3 Year Olds

4 day: Monday - Thursday \$280

3 day: Tuesday - Thursday \$240

4 Year Old

4 day Pre-K: Monday - Thursday \$290

(Enrichment classes are offered several times a year which extends the child's day until 1 p.m.)

Enrollment Qualifications

All children entering the 2-1/2 year old class must be 2 1/2 on or before Sept. 30, 2010.

All children entering the 3 year old class must be 3 on or before Sept. 30, 2010.

All children entering the 4 year old class must be 4 on or before Sept. 30, 2010.

To enroll, complete a registration form and return it to the Preschool office along with the registration fee.
